

Quick Guide to Variables in the 2022 GSS Cross-section (Release 4)

Background on Released Variables

The 2022 GSS was modified with a well-understood experimental design to aid in the transition from a traditionally face-to-face study to a multimode one, to employ modern data collection tools and collect data more cost effectively. This design made the 2022 GSS data collection more efficient and allowed for respondents to have more flexibility in how they preferred to complete the survey. This transition will continue forward into the 2024 GSS, which will employ a similar experimental design. The experimental design is described in detail in the codebook.

These changes come in the wake of the 2021 GSS Cross-section, which was fielded primarily via a web self-administered questionnaire. At the time, the web-based data collection was the only way that NORC could ensure the safety of all respondents and project staff, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Changes in trends beginning with the 2021 GSS Cross-section could have several potential sources, including both mode effects and genuine social change, with no clear way to disentangle those effects beyond item-level experiments on the survey.

All of the variables that users might consider standard for a complete GSS data release based on the GSS Replicating Core are below. Additionally, all variables from topical modules in the 2022 GSS Cross-section are displayed. Variables appear in one of three forms: bolded, regular, or as strike text.

- Bold variables are included in the 2022 GSS Cross-section Release 4 (R4)
- Regular variables are not included in the 2022 GSS Cross-section R4 but will be included in a future release.
- Strike variables will not be released in the 2022 GSS Cross-section data, as they were not part of the 2022 GSS Cross-section. Variables were excluded because of survey mode changes, decisions by the GSS Scientific Advisory Board, or other reasons. Variables which are not available on the 2022 GSS Cross-section may be included in future rounds of the GSS.

Additionally, some variables are colored red. These variables are new to the GSS as of 2022 GSS.
